

OAL Level 2 NVQ in Fitted Furniture Installation

WHO THE QUALIFICATION IS FOR

A Fitted Furniture Installer is responsible for preparing and installing furniture including kitchens, bedrooms, bathrooms and offices, shops, exhibitions and boat interiors. This is onsite at the customer's commercial or domestic premises. Learners taking this qualification will experience a wide variety of projects and interface closely with customers.

WHAT IS REQUIRED FROM LEARNERS?

Learners must achieve all mandatory units plus two optional units. The units are made up of the things you need to know and the things you need to be able to do to carry out your job safely and correctly. These are called Learning Outcomes, and all must be met to achieve the units.
